A material has been made that can absorb harmful airborne molecules and disperse cleaner air

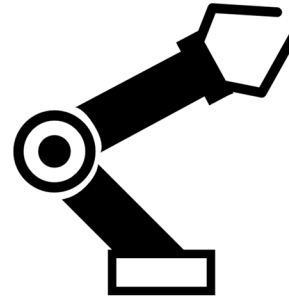
PRIVITISATION

Private company Circle was the first to take over an NHS hospital, but it withdrew from the 10 year contract after three years, leaving the public to pick up the bill

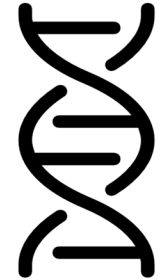
AUTOMATION

A genetically modified plant could have lower nutritional value

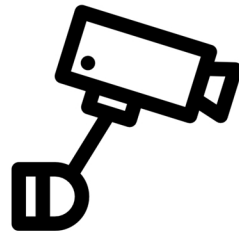
CENSORSHIP
